returning to You with renewed spirits.*


All Church Sunday Lenten Study

Calendaring our Lenten Discipline

It is the custom in the Christian church to practice “disciplines” during the Lenten Season. Lent has long been the primary time for renewing our “discipleship” by adopting some more rigorous discipline/s to heighten our spiritual awareness. Some of us cringe at the word “discipline”, as it conjures up unhappy memories of a childhood punishment. This is not that kind of discipline.

The idea of a Lenten discipline relates to the experience of being a disciple. The disciple is a learner, and in this case, the “discipline” is the way of learning. It includes instruction for the mind and exercises for the body.

In the United Methodist Church, some of our disciplines have included prayer, fasting from something (like meat, Diet Coke (ouch), facebook), meditation, Bible study, worship. This year, Webster United Methodist, together with our All-Church Study on Sunday mornings (9-10a), is also introducing a **Climate Justice Lenten Calendar**. Our emphasis is to become more aware of the cost to our environment of our choices of living. This calendar, created by our Environmental Justice Team, challenges us to experiment with new planet-friendly habits to add to our daily lives.

There are easy things to do, like reading a bible verse and visiting a earth justice website to read more. Then there are more challenging tasks, like walking/cycling to church, or turning down your thermostat by at least 1 degree. There is definitely something that every person can do.

We are all concerned, and some of us downright anxious, about the health of our planet. Let our church be a leader in helping to translate our concern into action. Please receive this calendar at the doors to the Sanctuary this Sunday, or click on our website to find it.


