## **All Church Sunday Lenten Study**


March 1-April 5 9a-10a Fellowship Hall

Dear Church,

This week I asked Pastor Sharon if I could write to you all regarding Jurisdictional and General Conference for the United Methodist Church. I have had the honor of serving as Jurisdictional delegate from Missouri since June 2019. I will be attending the Jurisdictional Conference in July of this year. Recently the delegation from Missouri met with other delegations in the South Central Jurisdiction in Oklahoma City. There we were able to discuss legislation for General Conference and interview bishop candidates that will be elected at Jurisdictional Conference.

One of the things we are charged with as delegates is to report regularly to our local congregations about what we are doing and discerning as a delegation. In church last week I was able to present about the different legislations and events that have been reported to us as a delegation. # Mark your Calendar! Opportunities to Serve with Hands In Mission Begin Sat., May 9 With Food Outreach Volunteering

Our Hands in Mission (H.I.M.) program offers the opportunity to volunteer our time and talents to serve local agencies and our community approximately once a month on Saturday mornings May through December.

Cook & Pack with Food Outreach: Saturday, May 9, 7:30am-12 noon we need 15 volunteers age of 16 or older to pack freshly-cooked meals in containers for Food Outreach in the Midtown area. Food Outreach serves meals each week to those living in the St. Louis community with HIV/AIDS and cancer. Meet in the church parking lot at 7:30 A.M., and we will carpool. We should return between 11:30 & 12 noon. Wear casual clothes, a cap or hat, and comfortable shoes with closed toes (such as tennis shoes). Sign up on the blue collection card in the bulletin.

<u>Deer Creek Stream Clean:</u> Sat., June TBD, 8am-11:30, Families and/or individuals will carpool from the church to work with our Boy Scout Troop cleaning up Deer Creek & ending the morning with a hot dog lunch at the church.

## LifeWise Backpacks & BBQ: Sat., August 8, morning or afternoon 3hr shift

Families/individuals will assist families served by Near-South Side social service agency LifewiseSTL to shop for school supplies and shoes, followed by light lunch

<u>Sharefest STL Area: Sat., October 3, 8:30am-12.</u> This event in partnership with local churches/denominations is a cooperative response to hunger, poverty, and injustice. Volunteers will drop off kits ,pack rice, sort garden seeds, assemble family food boxes or school kits, health kits, dental kits, or other kits, share lunch and a brief worship, and distribute collected items to Missouri agencies.

<u>LifeWise Holiday Market Work</u>, <u>Dec.5-10 (day & shift time TBD)</u> A team of volunteers will assist families with holiday shopping at the Lifewise Holiday Market, restock items, or straighten the shopping space as needed. Signup begins Nov. 1




