

A Word from Pastor Sharon:

My God is a Rock

Church,

Have you ever stood on the beach, just within the circumference of the waves? As each wave rolls in and washes over your feet, the receding wave drags a little of the sand back to the ocean from beneath your feet. It is a destabilizing feeling, isn't it, as your feet must adjust to find new purchase and re-capture your balance? With so many changes, uncertainties, and anxiousness that has marked this season of our lives together, I am more aware and grateful than ever for the comfort found in the certainty of God's love and grace for us. No matter how the sands may shift beneath our feet, God is like a rock, safe and solid. It seems like the perfect topic

for a sermon series for the month of July. It will shape up something like this, and I encourage you to meditate with me each week on the key scripture:

Week One — Solid Rock

The Lord is my solid rock, my fortress, my rescuer. My God is my rock — I take refuge in God! God is my shield, my salvation's strength, my place of safety. — Psalm 18

Week Two — Lead Me to the Rock

When my heart is weak, I cry out to you from the very ends of the earth. Lead me to the rock that is higher than I am. — Psalm 61

Week Three — Shelter of the Rock

Because God will shelter me in God's own dwelling during troubling times; God will hide me in a secret place in God's own tent; God will set me up. high, safe on a rock. — Psalm 27

Week Four — My Rock and My Redeemer


Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be pleasing to you, Lord, my rock and my redeemer. — Psalm 19


