UPDATE on COVID-19 PROTOCOL

As more of us have been inoculated with one of the COVID-19 vaccines, our community has been opening up quickly this summer. Our church, while staying on the conserving and cautious side, has begun to review our earlier safety protocols, and loosened many of the requirements, as follows:

- Worshippers are welcome to choose their own seats in the sanctuary. The
 ushers are no longer seating and releasing people from the pews.
- We are asking folks entering to maintain appropriate physical distancing, and on exiting, not to congregate in the aisles, but talk outside the building instead.
- Masks are still required, but for the vaccinated, may be taken off when seated. Out of a desire to protect others, including children who have not yet been vaccinated, unvaccinated persons need to keep their masks on throughout worship.
- Reservations are no longer required. There is room for you!

WUM Provides Worship at Bethesda Dilworth

On Sunday, July 18, 2021, our fully vaccinated and masked volunteers will return to Bethesda Dilworth (BD) to lead worship again. The skilled nursing facility is free of Covid-19 and the staff and residents have been fully vaccinated. Activities have gradually returned to normal which allows us to provide a half-hour chapel service.

At 2:00 pm volunteers gather on the second floor to receive assignments from Chaplain Michael Tooley, and then disperse to escort wheel-chair-bound residents who wish to attend. The half-hour service begins at 2:30. At BD we have the reputation of singing a lot because we begin singing beforehand. By 3:30 pm we

Film Screening and Discussion - July 21 at 7 p.m. in Fellowship Hall

The film, "On the Other Side of the Hill", reminds me of the saying that the grass is greener on the other side of the fence. That's only true because you aren't standing on the other side of the fence. Which leads me to the other advice-as-adage: walk a mile in someone else's shoes and you will think differently about anything. This short (30-minute) documentary will give us a chance to look at the challenges of the climate crisis and how rural Oregon residents are trying to address it.

The film is made available to us by <u>Interfaith Power & Light</u>, an ecumenical faith-based non-profit that seeks to find ways of being good stewards of the planet God created. They write:

The film is a hopeful, inspiring look at local leaders on the ground in rural America who are leading climate action in their communities. But it is also about coming together, finding common ground and new climate frameworks, and shining a light on rural voices as we envision a path forward.

I hope you'll be able to join in the viewing and discussion in Fellowship Hall on Wednesday, July 21, at 7 p.m. We will plan to be socially distanced and unvaccinated persons should wear a mask.
