

#### Friends,

I watched an interview with Dr. Fauci on Sunday's Meet the Press to confirm what other news sources have been reporting: the Delta variant of the COVID-19 virus is expected to continue to spread aggressively through the fall. Missouri is a red state on the chart of hotspots, indicating we have lots of the Delta variant cases emerging already, and our vaccination numbers are not impressive. Dr. Fauci declared this wave to be essentially a pandemic of the unvaccinated, but there is the potential for breakthrough cases, even if you are vaccinated. And if you have a breakthrough case of the Delta variant, you can pass it onto others.

Your church staff and I have looked at this from all sides, and in good conscience, I cannot see any way to successfully mitigate the risks for all generations sufficiently to hold our 125+ Anniversary Celebrations this year. They included a mission event, a justice event, and our worship with the Bishop followed by a big potluck dinner, all to happen in October.

After consulting with Tom Pacatte/Safety Team Chair, Deane Looney/Lay Leader, and Jackie Richert/Church Council Chair, I am officially postponing the events to 2022. I hope to announce new dates soon.

Friends, we're in a better place than we were last year, but we're not in the clear yet. Hang in there, take one day at a time, and we'll make adjustments as we venture forward through these weird times together. There will be a time to celebrate in a big way. In the meantime, there is still much to celebrate in our lives.

#### **UPDATE on COVID-19 PROTOCOL**

As more of us have become inoculated with one of the COVID-19 vaccines, our community has been opening up quickly this summer. Our church, while staying on the conserving and cautious side, continues to review our earlier safety protocols. Please follow the guidelines below:
