UPDATE on COVID-19 PROTOCOL

As more of us have received one of the COVID-19 vaccines, our community has been opening up. Our church, while staying on the cautious side, has begun to review our earlier safety protocols and loosen some of them. The current requirements are:

- Worshippers are welcome to choose their own seats in the sanctuary. The ushers are no longer seating and releasing people from the pews.
- We are asking folks entering to maintain appropriate physical distancing, and on exiting, not to congregate in the aisles, but talk outside the building instead.
- Because of the virulence of the Delta variant, and out of a desire to protect others, including children who have not yet been vaccinated, we need to keep our masks on throughout worship.
- Reservations are no longer required. There is room for you!
