# VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY: BECOME A DRIVER FOR THE SHEPHERD'S CENTER OF WEBSTER-KIRKWOOD

Several of us from Webster UM already volunteer by driving older adults to medical appointments through the Shepherd's Center's Transportation Ministry. We find it a rewarding experience firstly because many seniors need help getting to appointments but it is also a way to meet people and have a good time. Everyone I know really enjoys the experience every time we drive someone. It works out that we have been asked to drive about once per month. We stay with the riders so we can take them back home after the appointment so each drive only takes about two hours of our time.

We are now being scheduled by an email scheduler. We receive a list of appointments that includes all the information we need. We just click on the one we choose and all the needed information is provided.

More drivers are needed since the program has grown over the years and to replace those not able to continue driving.
