BREAKING OUR LENT

This feels like the loooongest Lenten Season ever, doesn't it? Maybe like two years!? But the chance to discover new life is right around the corner! I'm inviting you to join us in preparing your heart for it. Just like breakfast "breaks our fasting," Holy Week breaks the Lenten Season.

Holy Week begins with **Palm Sunday at 10:30 am on April 10th** with palms. Once again, we will re-enact the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem with the waving of palms, and the opening of our hearts to receive Him.

Our **Maundy Thursday celebration** will be led by our Mountain Service Band at 7:30 pm in their original worship space, Fellowship Hall. Join us for a dramatic worship service of candlelight, music, and scripture. Holy Communion will be shared.

We will enjoy a hot **Easter breakfast** together once again from 9:00 am – 10:15 am on April 17th! Bring your guests to join us in Fellowship Hall for homemade breakfast casserole, fresh fruit, hot coffee/tea, and juice.

In-Person Easter Worship will be at 10:30 am on April 17th in our beautiful Sanctuary. Worship will include traditional music, Holy Communion, a children's story with gifts, and the tradition of our **flower cross**. Bring your posey for the Cross if you have one, and someone who needs to feel the joy of new life!

Fresh flowers will also be available at the doors to the Sanctuary. Masking will be optional. Childcare will be available in our nursery.

YOUTH V. GOV: A FILM OF HOPE IN THE CLIMATE CRISIS
