a Message from Our Pastor

2022 TOWER GROVE PRIDE September 24–25th

Dear Friends.

Back in 2013, our church family struggled with the invitation to become a Reconciling Church. The Reconciling Movement is a movement within Methodism that is passionate in offering a public, intentional, and explicit welcome to members of the LGBTQIA+ community.

Many said we were already welcoming to all persons. Why do we need to hang up a rainbow flag and write into our welcoming statement that we honor all sexual orientations and gender identities in our church family?

The reason is, as you sadly may know, it has been the collective experience of many of our LGBTQIA+ siblings that church has not been a safe place for them to be their authentic, God-created selves. Unless they pretended to be straight, they may have been shunned, pressured to conform, or even asked to leave.

To be a Reconciling Church means that we make our welcoming public, intentional, and explicit to remove fearful assumptions of what an experience might be like when they enter our doors. In January 2014, our church family voted overwhelmingly to join the Reconciling Network, placed the Pride flag in our front yard, and printed this statement on the front page of our website:

"We welcome into the full life of our church people of every race, ethnicity, social or economic status, age, faith history, physical or mental ability, family configuration, sexual orientation, and gender identity."



Later in September, we have another opportunity to make a public, intentional, and explicit statement of welcome. On September 24–25th, Webster United Methodist will be sharing in the hosting of a double-wide booth at the 2022 Tower Grove Pride Festival. Reconciling Methodists from all over St. Louis City and County will be sharing this space, offering an invitation, hugs, materials, and swag.

Friends, I pledged that 8 persons from our church would step forward and help host the booth with our UMC siblings, and I will be one of them. If you would like to participate, go to SignUp Genius at this link to find the day and time that works best for you:

 18 reusable cleaning wipes * No terrycloth, microfiber, or paper towels * Remove from packaging 5 scouring pads (no stainless-steel pads 	*No screw lids *May be used but must be free from all residual product *Advertisements on the outside are acceptable
with soap in them) *Remove from packaging	One 16-40 oz. bottle of liquid household cleaner concentrate
36-50 clothespins	*No spray cleaners
One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic)	2 pairs of kitchen gloves *Durable for multiple uses *Remove from packaging
One 16-34 oz. bottle of dish soap	One pair of work gloves
One 4-8 oz. air freshener pump spray (liquid, not gel)
