A Message from Our Pastor

ALL-CHURCH BIBLE STUDY - "FORGIVENESS"

Bubble Study from Feb. 26th - April 2nd

Fresh from a host of holiday gatherings with family and friends, it might be a good time to talk about forgiveness. Many relationship dynamics can be a little complicated. Renewed relationships at the holidays can stir up old rivalries, poke at unhealed wounds, and aggravate un-reconciled feelings.

Learning to ask and grant forgiveness is necessary in our lives because of an inescapable fact of human nature: we are bound to hurt each other, sometimes on purpose and sometimes unintentionally. If we are to live grace-filled lives, if we are ever to fully know freedom and joy, then we have to learn how to practice forgiveness.

But forgiving others and humbly asking for forgiveness are also central disciplines for Christian believers. Lent, a time to reflect on our Christian journey, is an appropriate time to deepen our understanding and practice of forgiveness.

During our 6-week Lenten study, we will gather at 9 am each Sunday from February 26th - April 2nd in Fellowship Hall, after choosing our donuts and filling our coffee cups. At round tables (bubbles), we will explore what the Bible has to say about forgiveness, why we would bother with the difficult work involved, and the dynamics of seeking resolution with others, ourselves, and with God. For some, this will not be an easy conversation. But it will offer a place to begin a journey toward healing and wholeness, and release from the pain that has the power to hold us hostage.

Whom do you know

- who bears emotional wounds that do not seem to heal?
- who is angry with God for the way things turned out?
- who does not seem to be able to forgive themselves for a lousy choice? or
- who wrestles with a bad ending to a relationship?

Whom do you know who needs to hear a word about forgiveness? Invite them to think about working it out in a safe place among people who care.
