A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

A Time to Share

The traditional story of the first Thanksgiving centers on the community that was created among the Indigenous people, the Wampanoag tribe, and the English colonists who arrived in 1620 to the shores of Plymouth, Massachusetts. In their first year, the pilgrims suffered enormous losses from the brutal winter, illness, and starvation. Pilgrim leaders credited the support of their native neighbors for their very survival.

In the fall of 1621, a harvest meal was created to celebrate their community. Tables were filled with fowl and venison, fish, vegetables, and pumpkins. Prayers of gratitude for life, food, and friendship were offered to God. After the feast, the men are said to have fired guns together, run foot races, and shared liquor.

On Tuesday, November 21st at 6:00pm, another community will gather to give thanks. Webster United Methodist will host the 3rd ecumenical Community Thanksgiving Service. It originated in 2021 at Emmanuel Episcopal Church and was carried forward last year at Christ Lutheran Church. Many will share in the leadership of the service, and a community choir will share two anthems. Rev. Dr. Bastion, Executive Director of Webster Rock Hills Ministries (WRHM), will bring the message about caring for our community. We are encouraged to bring a canned good to add to our monetary offering for WRHM. A free-will offering will also be taken up for the Firewood for Elders program.

This service is an opportunity to recognize the importance of community for our shared well-being, and to remember our indebtedness to the early indigenous peoples who shared their land and knowledge with immigrants seeking refuge in what was a new world for them.

I look forward to hosting this special event with you.
