Romans 10:14-15 ceb

14 So how can they call on someone they don't have faith in? And how can they have faith in someone they haven't heard of? And how can they hear without a preacher? 15 And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who announce the good news."

Greetings, siblings in Christ!

I want to use my space this week to challenge you all from our topic Sunday. Spend some time this week considering how you came to Jesus, how Jesus changed your life, and who is one person-in your family circle, friend circle, or even a stranger-that you might tell about your faith experience.

I know that the thought of talking to someone, any one, about our own faith experience in our current cultural climate, might be awkward, uncomfortable, or scary-and possibly all three. So remember a few things as you think and pray over this:
