Two local institutions -- a hundred-year-old church congregation and the St. Louis County Housing Authority -have been working tenaciously to build affordable senior housing on the former site of Peace United Church of Christ at the corner of Lockwood and Plant. Their application for low income housing tax credits was passed over last year, but they are trying again, this time with the benefit of lessons learned and additional guidance from the Missouri Housing Development Corporation.
