Over the next couple of months, on two specific Sundays, we are going to try to re-establish two key roles in our Sunday worship: ushers and acolytes. We are not limiting this to certain age groups, and this is not a role you will be asked to fill every Sunday. 



DECEMBER MEALS FOR EPWORTH DROP IN CENTER FOR YOUTH

Access to food is just one of the challenges faced by all too many unhoused youth, but one we can help with.....and have since the onset of COVID. United Women in Faith invite you to join in providing five meals and Grab & Go Bags in mid-December for the Epworth Drop In Center. Options are: make a main dish for 10 (recipe to be provided), provide 80 cookies, or make a cash donation that will be used to purchase pizza and sides. For prep of one of the food items, check the Connection Card this Sunday or contact Carolyn Redmore (cdredmore@aol.com). Cash donations go to UWF Treasurer, Lettie Morse via her mail box in the church office or by mail (411 Forest Green Dr., 63119). Make checks out to United Women in Faith.

The Drop In Center provides comprehensive services to unhoused youth through immediate and longer term support, e.g. transitional housing. Monday through Friday up to 40 youth come to the DIC for a meal, fellowship, counseling and other services. Grab & Go Bags help with food over the weekend. Some Grab & Go Bags are distributed on the street by DIC staff to serve and build relationships with youth not ready to come to the DIC.




