A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Mark 15:32a ceb

32 Let the Christ, the king of Israel, come down from the cross. Then we'll see and believe."

Greetings, siblings in Christ!

I hope you are finding our Lenten series challenging and hopeful, because I can't think of a better way to describe the season of Lent. It is challenging because we have to face our own sin, our own failings, our own mortality. But it is hopeful because we know the end of the story, and that through that end God has a different plan for our lives and our eternities.

Over the remaining four weeks we'll look at the Passion stories of the gospel; their similarities and differences, and what each gospel writer might have been saying or presenting through their version/experience/memories of these events. One of the things that Matt Rawle states early in his book is that the word *passion* comes from the Latin *to suffer*. He asks what you are willing to suffer for (i.e.: What is your passion)? I invite you to consider thinking about that as we move towards Easter/Resurrection Sunday, and we consider where deep passion can take us.

Invite someone to join you at church this Sunday-at 9am for chapter three of our book study, or 10:30 for worship-as we look at Mark's Passion story, and what it says to us. Hope to see you and a guest on Sunday!
