

I wanted to lay out here the dates and events of Holy Week which I shared last Sunday in worship, so that those of you who are planning your Easter celebrations can add these to your calendars.

We will start with our usual worship time of 10:30 am on **Palm Sunday**, April 13th. Of course, we will have palms to wave, and we will start with our youth and children marching into the Sanctuary with theirs.

Then on April 17th, Maundy Thursday, we will have dinner with Unity UMC in our Fellowship Hall from 5 pm-6 pm, followed by our service at 6:30 pm in the Sanctuary. On April 18th, we will have a **Good Friday** service (of about 30 min) beginning at 6:30 pm that evening. It will include some congregational participation that promises to bring what Jesus did into your own life.

On **Easter Sunday**, April 20th, we will celebrate Easter with a breakfast together at 9 am, followed by a joyful celebration of worship at 10:30 am, and an Easter egg hunt planned by our youth at 12 pm.

Invite a family to join us that week, as we look at all the highs and lows, joys, sorrows, and ultimate hope of the Easter experience. This Sunday, we will discusschapter four of our book study-as we look at Matthew's Passion story. Hope to see you and a guest on Sunday!
